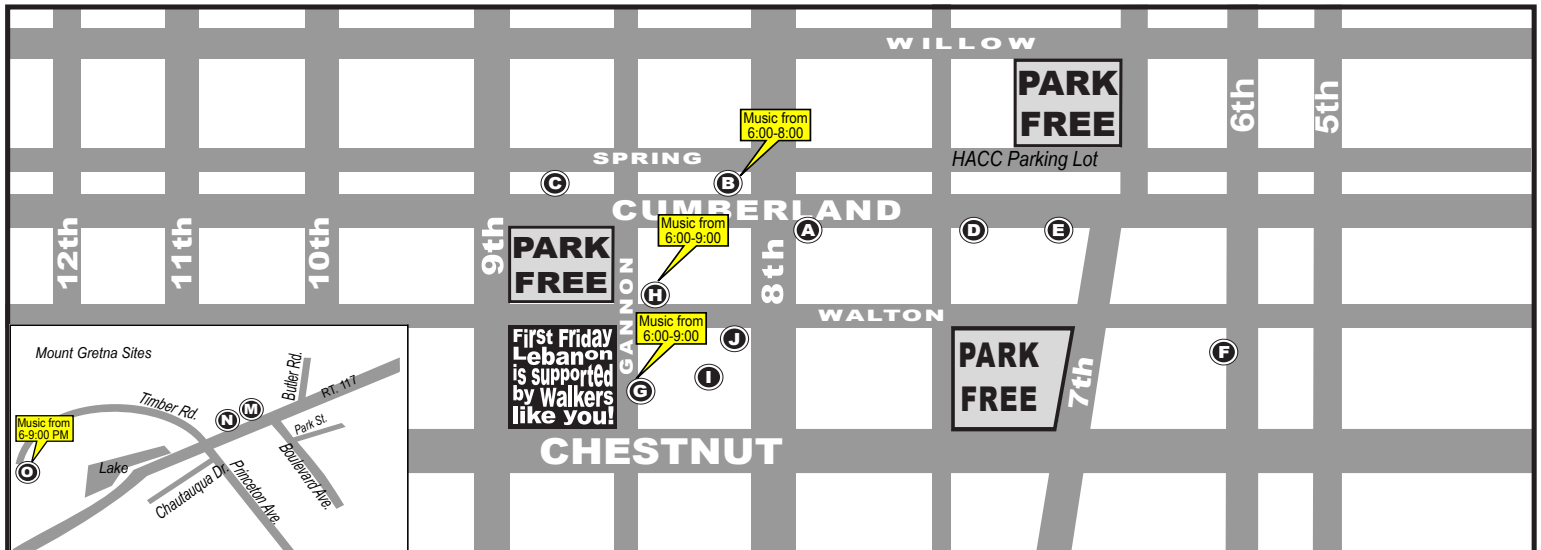
**(K) Royal Oaks Vineyard (Not on Map)**
