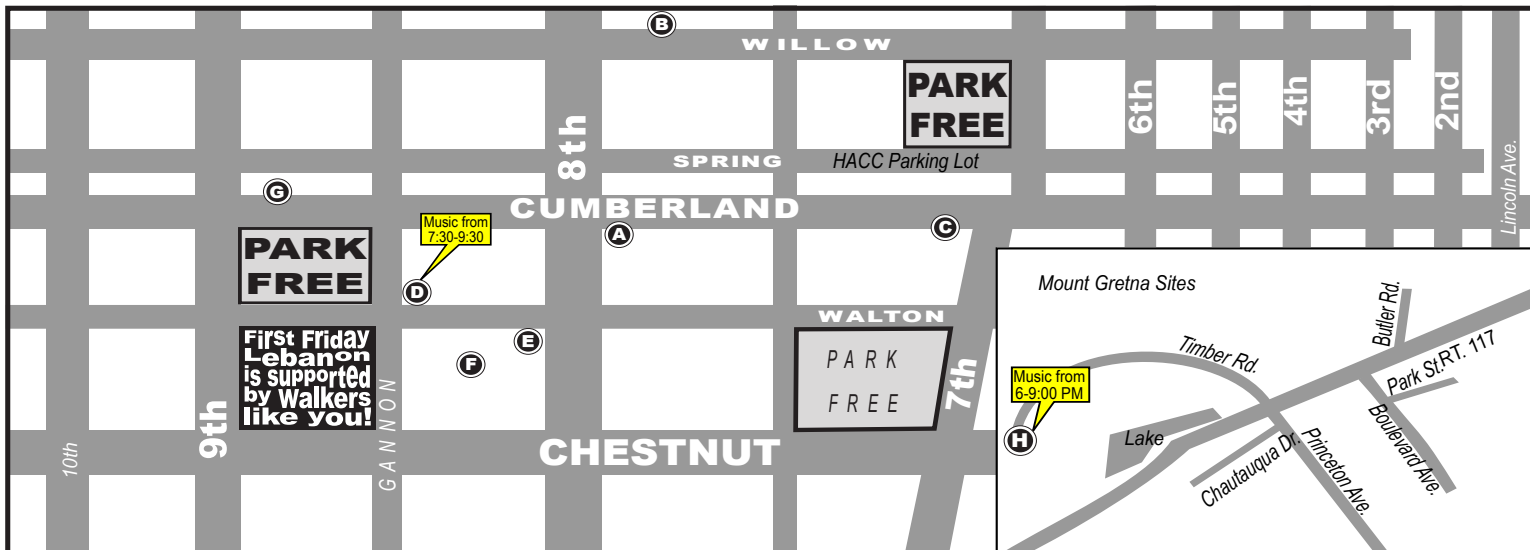

Sacred: Image, Text, Ritual

Five major religions Buddhism, Christianity, Hinduism, Islam, and Judaism, provide the focus of this exhibition exploring sacred art. An array of objects, such as gold Jewish Torah finials, an ancient Buddhist Gandharan sculpture, a Christian Russian Hodigitria icon, an Islamic 17th century leaf of the Koran, and a 10th-11th century Hindu stele representing Vishnu are some of the items included. This variety of work representing themes of image, text, and ritual provides a lens with which to explore these unique traditions and the ways in which they intersect.
